We also have two schools (one from Denmark and one from Turkey on our waiting list in case of any late drop outs)

We have a professional camera team ready for the final day to film all the big events and for the last week, the committee has been interviewing every day to sort out the Media Team, Administration Team, Chair Team and delegates from EEB2 - I can tell you now there are over 130 EEB2 students involved overall which is a superb number really (remember it was 7 per year 2 years ago). Good news is the students launched a campaign to attract new teachers and three teachers have stepped forward interested in leading this project into a third year - a lot of the reason for that is that they know it is very well supported by the APEEE (one from Finland, one from Holland and one from Belgium).

Financial news - overall the budget looks good at the moment - the collection of money starts now, so there is no new financial news yet. Our aim is to be self-financing, but if we do not achieve this we will reach out to the money APEEE has allocated and the school which has pledged support.

We are truely grateful for your generosity and which has motivated the students, the teachers and the school management in organising this event.
